- Pick one or more of these scriptures
 - Deuteronomy 10:12; Ecclesiastes 12:13;
 James 1:5
 - How do this either give more insight or add to the verses above?
 - Which one, including Proverbs 1:7 and the story of Solomon are most applicable to today?

- How did you pursue you spouse when you were dating? Do you know of any stories of others who pursued their spouse in a unique way?
 - How do those stories compare to how we should pursue wisdom?
 - Talk about wise people in your life, past or present.
 - Where did they gain wisdom?
 - What wisdom did they give you?
 - Have you ever feared and loved the same person? In what way was it good or bad?
 - Are we to fear God and nothing else? What does the Bible say about that?
 - What other fears do you have in your life?
 Are they significant or minor?
 - How do they take your energy? Time? Attention?
 - What would it mean to only fear God in your life?
 - How often do you pray first when needing wisdom?
 - Why is it good to pray for wisdom?
