LIFE TO THE FULL

1. Have you ever doubted God's absolute authority and wisdom? Explain.
2. How were the Pharisees from John 9 acting in doubt when they continued to question Jesus's actions?
3. What stuck out to you from John 9? What stuck out to you from the sermon this week?

God Reigns on High

4. Who are some people in the Bible who questioned God? (For examples, see Genesis 18:12, Judges 6:13, Jonah, Luke 1:18 & 34.)

What happened to them?

5. Read Isaiah 55:8-9. What would be the dangers of forgetting this truth?
6. Read Job 38 (and 39 if you have time). How significant do these chapters make you feel?
7. Did Job really forget that God did all that He said in these chapters? Do we forget that God does those things?

Why did God tell Job that? What good is such a reminder?

8. Read Job 40:1-9. Have you ever felt like Job did in this passage? Have you ever prayed that way to the Lord?
9. Why do we question God?
10. Read 1 Chronicles 29:11-13. Do you ever feel like falling on your knees and praying like this to God? Why or why not?
11. How has this study helped you see God's unexplainable sovereignty?
