 - Why is faithfulness important to relationships?
- How would you define Covenant?
 - What are some covenants used today? (Move beyond things we sign.)

- Who are the 7 people God made major covenants with in the Bible? (Adam, Noah, Abraham, Moses, David and Jesus)
- What is our covenant with God today? (Answers and discussion following...)
 - We are to live in faithfulness to Jesus Christ.
 - What does that look like in each of our lives?
 - What are the consequences of following God? (a right relationship with God which result in our active faith in Jesus, our connection two the Holy Spirit, and our belonging to the church).
 - How can we easily fall into "rule keeping for God rather than responsibilities we fulfill for the good of his household... the church."?
