1. 1 Corinthians 15:3... How would you explain why Jesus' death for our sins is 'of first importance' for us to understand and believe?
2. 1 Corinthians 15:4-8... What evidence does Paul provide of Jesus' literal death and resurrection that stands out most to you?
3. Colossians 2:12... As you read this scripture, how does this impact

your perspective of baptism?

4. Colossians 3:12-14... What does this scripture reveal about God and what His desire is for the lives of His people?
