- Read Romans 1
 - What is the most intriguing verse to you in Romans 1?
 - What doctrine statements does Paul make in Romans 1 (maybe define doctrine)?
 - What "how to statements" does he make in Romans 1 (or what would you surmise)?

- Reread Romans 1:16
 - Besides Jesus, what's good news" that you have been excited to share with others?
 - How do you share the good news of Jesus with others?
 - Why is that important?
 - How have you seen the power of God (Maybe besides physical healings, let this question focus more on life change)?
 - Is there anything in you that wonders if some people can't believe and therefore can't be saved (I know everyone "knows" the right answer but do we sometimes think differently)?
- Who are you obligated to reach with the Gospel (Romans 1:14-15)?
- Who had the most influence in you becoming a Christian? Who have you had influence in becoming a Christian?
- Would you write down "I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ" and put it on your mirror, dash, forehead (haha) or somewhere you will see it often?
