- 2. Consider this quote. What does it mean to you? Is it true? Why or why not?

What do you do with your gifts?

- 3. Ephesians 2:10 makes it sound like believers have a purpose. What is it? How has God prepared our work? How has He prepared us?
- 4. Read Matthew 5:13-16. What does this have to do with gifts and talents?
- 5. Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-11. What is the point that Paul (the author) is trying to make? Can God ever give the wrong gift to the wrong person?
- 6. Read 1 Peter 4:10-11. What does Peter say we should do with our gifts? What reason does he give?
- 7. Read Matthew 6:1-4. Why do we do good things? What motivates you to do good things?

A Skilled Example

8. Read Exodus 35:10, 30-35. Moses asks for volunteers to make the sacred things of the tabernacle. Who responds? Why? (Exodus 36-

39 summarizes the crafters' works.)

- 9. Could this call apply to you? What are you skilled in? Why does God use people to do work for Him anyway?
- 10. How can you use your gifts for God this week? What would this service accomplish?
