- 11. Which image do you want to bear, that of dust or of heaven?

## A Committed Man

- 12. Read Genesis 6:5-7:5. How did Noah decide? What could have kept him from that decision?
- 13. How did Noah commit? What could have kept him from his commitment?
- 14. How did Noah succeed? What could have kept him from success?
- 15. How can you use Gideon's and Noah's examples as encouragement to follow the Lord despite the world?
