6. How well do you have to know someone before you can tell whether they are imitating Christ? What do you look for?
7. Read John 15:1-5. How can we be sure to bear much fruit?

What does it mean to "remain" and "abide" in Jesus?

8. Why do we need human mentors rather than just all of us saying W.W.J.D. (What Would Jesus Do)?

Couldn't we just listen to the Holy Spirit (John 14:26) more efficiently than following mortal teachers (Hebrews 13:7)?

9. Identify an area of your life that you are relatively competent in. How are you using this area to honor God and imitate Christ?
  
10. Are there people in your sphere of influence who need guidance in that area?
  
11. Read Matthew 7:3-5. What should you do (besides pray!) before you tell people that they need your help?
  
12. What has this study taught you about mentoring?
  
13. Why does it matter?
