1. Share about a time that a leader in your life served those “lower” than they were. How did you see the leader differently after this?
2. What stuck out to you from the sermon this week? Explain.

3. Read John 13:1-17. Why did Jesus wash the disciples’ feet?

What can we learn from this passage?

4. Read Philippians 2:1-5. Consider each command in these verses. What is the big idea Paul is writing to the Church in Philippi?

How can we follow these commands today?

What do these verses have to do with leadership?

5. Read Romans 15:2, 1 Corinthians 10:24, and 1 Corinthians 12:12-14, 25-27. Why is it so important for believers to serve each other?

Think about the analogy that the Church is a body. How does servant leadership fit into this idea?

If a leader did not serve the rest of the body, what would happen?

6. Read Luke 9:23-27. What does it mean to deny yourself? What does it mean to take up your cross?

Why would Jesus give this advice to ALL who want to be His disciples? Is this command any different for those who want to lead?

7. What has this study taught you about servant leadership?
8. Why does it matter?
