- 2. Consider this quote. What is Benson's reasoning for putting God first? Should this be why we put God first?

If not, why not? What should be the reason we put God first?

3. Why does God ask us to put Him first? Does He need our worship?

- 4. What is your favorite Bible verse describing how awesome God is?
- 5. Read Psalm 145:1-13. Why does David praise the Lord? Is it because he earns more benefits the more he says nice things about God? (See verse 12 again.) Explain.
- 6. Read Romans 11:36. What does this mean to you? Read 1

Corinthians 10:31. Does this mean we owe God? Why or why not?

Me first?

The sermon made it clear that God should be first in our lives, not money or family. However, we often put someone else into God's prominent position. Ourselves.

- 7. Decision Have you ever asked, "Will it make me happy?" What is a better question you could ask instead?
- 8. Dollar Do you ever spend money that only benefits you? Is that wrong? Whose money is it really? Explain.
- 9. Relationship Maybe you think you love God more than you love your family. However, do you love God more than you love yourself? (If you think you don't love yourself, read Ephesians 5:25 and talk to a pastor.)
- 10. Day Is prayer the first thing you do in the morning? If so, what does that look like? If not, why not? Does it matter whether you are a morning person?
- 11. Problem If you try to solve problems on your own, are you being self-sufficient or stubbornly refusing God's help? Is there a difference?
