1. Have you ever found yourself in a debate with another Christian about the “proper” way to take communion? Tell us about it.
2. What do you typically do or think during communion? After this week’s essay, do you think there is anything you need to change or add to your communion experience?
3. Read Exodus 12-13. What foreshadowing of Jesus do you see in the establishment of the Passover?
4. Read Matthew 26:26-28, Luke 22:14-20, 1 Corinthians 11:24-25. What comes to mind as you meditate on these verses?

Do you sense a challenge or conviction from these verses? How so?

5. If you went to church as a child, how do you remember the celebration of communion?

6. How do you prepare yourself spiritually for communion?
7. How could we make this private moment in the service more communal?
8. What could you do as a group to plan a full meal that would include communion?
9. Do you think sharing a communion celebration in your home is the kind of practice you should incorporate into your regular routine? Why or why not?
