1. Explain the last bit of good news you received that you couldn’t wait to share. How did you tell people? How long were you excited for?
2. What things has Jesus done in your life that you could share with others?
3. What stood out to you from the sermon this week?

4. When you think of Jesus Christ, what do you think of first? (Title, aspect, action, image, etc.)

How does this initial idea shape the way you treat Him?

5. Read Psalm 96. What words/phrases jump out at you?

How does the Psalmist’s view of God compare with your view of Jesus?

6. Read Hebrews 1:1-4 and Colossians 1:15-20.

How does remembering the supremacy of Jesus affect our attitude toward sharing His Gospel?

How does remembering what Jesus did to sacrifice Himself for our salvation affect our attitude toward sharing His Gospel?

Which is more compelling for you? Why?

7. Are you uncomfortable giving Jesus the title of Emperor? Why or why not? What difference would it make in the Church if we actually treated Jesus as an Emperor and not merely a Savior?
8. What is one area of your life that you do not currently allow Jesus Christ to rule and reign in? What can you do differently this week?
9. What has this study taught you about the Good News of Jesus Christ?
10. Why does it matter?
