- 2. What stood out to you from the sermon this week?

Power

- 3. Read Acts 2. Do you think it adds or reduces confusion that we don't often see such visible displays of the Spirit's power in the church today? Why?
- 4. Why is the Holy Spirit such a confusing and challenging topic for people?
- 5. Read John 16:13-14, Galatians 5:22-23, and Ephesians 1:13-14. What comes to mind as you read these verses? Is God challenging you through anything with these verses?
- 6. Read Mark 13:11, Romans 8:26-27, and 2 Peter 1:20-21. What are some principles you use to help you determine if you're hearing from the Holy

Spirit or your own mind?

- 7. The Spirit is always communicating in various ways. Brainstorm together ways that we can pay more attention to the various ways the Holy Spirit wants to speak to us.
- 8. Read Titus 3:3-7. What is a role of the Holy Spirit in our salvation?
- 9. Of all the things the Spirit does for us, which is most important to you right now? Why?
- 10. What has this study taught you about the Holy Spirit?
- 11. Why does it matter?
