3. Read Acts 2. Do you think it adds or reduces confusion that we don't often see such visible displays of the Spirit's power in the church today? Why?
4. Why is the Holy Spirit such a confusing and challenging topic for people?
5. Read John 16:13-14, Galatians 5:22-23, and Ephesians 1:13-14. What comes to mind as you read these verses? Is God challenging you through anything with these verses?
6. Read Mark 13:11, Romans 8:26-27, and 2 Peter 1:20-21. What are some principles you use to help you determine if you're hearing from the Holy

Spirit or your own mind?

7. The Spirit is always communicating in various ways. Brainstorm together ways that we can pay more attention to the various ways the Holy Spirit wants to speak to us.
8. Read Titus 3:3-7. What is a role of the Holy Spirit in our salvation?
9. Of all the things the Spirit does for us, which is most important to you right now? Why?
10. What has this study taught you about the Holy Spirit?
11. Why does it matter?
