 10. Read Ephesians 2:13-18. What does this tell you about Christ? Be specific, and did anything surprise you?
 - 11. Read Matthew 12:15-21. What does this tell you about Christ? Be specific, and did anything surprise you?
 - 12. Read John 8:49-59. What does this tell you about Christ? Be specific, and did anything surprise you?
 - 13. What have you learned about Jesus this week? Which Bible verses do you (or would you) use for explaining Jesus?

TAKEAWAY: Read Isaiah 53 and Colossians 1 several times this week. Ask yourself: What is the most important thing I know?
