- Have you ever had to go against the crowd? What was the situation?
 - If you have, were you nice about it? Harsh? Did you explain to people why?
- What are reasons to go against society?
 - What is the best way to show your belief?
- Read Psalm 1
 - Take each verse individually and apply it to our lives today (Maybe combine 4-5).
 - If you summed up Psalm 1 in a sentence, what would it be?
- What is the difference between walking, standing and sitting with non-Christians?
- What are 10 specific ways that you can walk, stand and sit closer to God.
- Is it better to know what you are for or what you are against?

He bled out without tapping out on the cross, so that he could save his bride. The church. That's me and you. He is our example for how to love our families.”
 - How can you live this out this week?
- How can you be closer to God?
