Read Exodus 5:2. Why wouldn't Pharaoh obey the Lord? Could that be your reason *to* obey the Lord?

Read Jeremiah 27:4 and Titus 1:16 and 1 John 1:6. If we know God, what are we expected to do?

Read 1 Kings 18:36-37. What is the reason Elijah wants the Lord to act?

What connection is there between knowing the Lord and obeying Him?

Read Acts 5:29-32. What were Peter's reasons for obeying God?

What excuses does the world give for not obeying God? What excuses are you trapped by for not obeying God?

You may ask, "Isn't Faith Enough?" Aren't we saved through faith alone? (See John 3:16, John 20:31, Romans 3:22, 5:1, 10:9-10, Ephesians 2:8-9, Philippians 3:9, etc.) Right?

Read James 2:14-26. How is obeying God connected with our faith in God?

What has this study showed you about obeying God?
