Read Genesis 1:4, 2 Samuel 22:29, Psalm 139:11-12, and John 12:46. How does God treat light and darkness? Why does God treat light and darkness differently? Read Matthew 5:14-16. What does it mean that we (believers) are the light of the world? What does it mean to shine our light?

Read Ephesians 5:8-14 and 1 Thessalonians 5:5-11. How are these passages similar? How are they different?

From these passages, how are believers supposed to live as light? Why?

What has this study showed you about choosing God's light over hiding in darkness?
