## **ALIVE**

- 3. What stuck out to you from Colossians 3? What stuck out to you from the sermon?

## **UNITY**

- 4. Read Colossians 3:1-17. If all you knew about unity in God came from these verses, what would you know?
- 5. Compare Colossians 3:1-17 with Ephesians 4:1-6,17-24. What differences do you notice? What similarities do you notice?
- 6. Why do you think Paul wrote similar messages to churches in two different cities?
- 7. Read Ephesians 4:15 and Romans 15:5-7. How are we to have unity? What is the purpose that brings us together?
- 8. Read John 17:21. Why does Jesus call us to unity?
- 9. What do you think is the most important reason for striving after unity among other believers? What can you do to live at peace together (Romans 12:19)?

## **LIFE CLOTHES**

- 10. Read Romans 8:1. Read the verse again. How do you react to such news?
- 11. Read Romans 8:2. Read the verse again. How do you react to such news?
- 12. Read Romans 8:3-8, 13. Is it any wonder that God calls us to live by His Spirit? With this obligation (vv. 12-13) to live by the Spirit, is God forcing all His children to follow a bunch of rules? Explain.
- 13. How does Galatians 5:13-18 connect freedom, unity, and living by the Spirit?
- 14. How wasteful is it to go on sinning after we have been freed? How does it compare to leaving a gift in its wrapping paper or jumping in the mud after a shower or clinging to manacles after being released from slavery?
- 15. How can you use the verses from this study to "clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience" (Col 3:12b)? What will you do this week to promote the "unity of the Spirit" (Eph 4:3)? What will you do this week to live "alive with Christ" (Eph 2:5)?
