



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Have you ever needed to be rescued? What happened? Who rescued you?
2. Consider this quote. What does it mean? Who saved people before Jesus was born? (For a hint, look at Romans 4 and read about Abraham, righteousness, faith, promise, grace, and Jesus.)

Jesus and Boaz

3. Read 2 Samuel 7:23 and Psalm 78:35 and 1 Corinthians 7:23. What do these verses have in common? What do they call God?
4. What does Ruth call Boaz in Ruth 3:9? What did this mean for her?
5. What does Boaz tell Ruth in Ruth 3:11? What does God tell us in Isaiah 41:14? What does this mean for us?
6. Read Ruth 4:8-10. What does Boaz do for Ruth? How is this similar to what Jesus does for us?

Jesus and the Throne

7. Read 2 Samuel 7:12-16, Isaiah 9:6-7 and Luke 1:32-33. What is the link between David and Jesus? How did God establish David's throne forever?

Jesus and the Temple

8. Read 2 Chronicles 3:14. What does the temple need a curtain for? Read Hebrews 9:1-9. What did the veil do? In Isaiah 25:7-8, what did God promise would happen to the veil/curtain?
9. Read Matthew 27:50-51. What happened at the moment Jesus died? Read Hebrews 10:19-22. What did the veil symbolize? Read 2 Corinthians 3:13-18. What does it mean to us that the veil has been torn away?
