- 4. What differences do you see between the leadership of David and Saul? Which attributes can you see in leaders around you?
- 5. What makes you angry? What does this reveal about your heart?
- 6. How do you act "in the cave"? What does this reveal about your heart?
- 7. In what ways do we typically base our judgments on outward appearances rather than looking at the heart of a person?

- 8. Read Mark 1:15, Matthew 19:24, Luke 9:62, Luke 18:29-30, Romans 14:17, and 1 Corinthians 15:50. What do you learn from these verses?
- 9. How near is the kingdom of God? How do we enter it?
- 10. Read Matthew 13. How can parables bring us an understanding of the kingdom of heaven?
- 11. What would it be like to live in a place where God is our boss?
- 12. Why don't we live that way now?
- 13. What has this study taught you about the kingdom of God?
- 14. Why does it matter?
