BIBLE STUDY DISCUSSION GUIDE

1 Thessalonians 1 April 27, 2025



Welcome. Icebreaker: "What's one thing you loved about this past Sunday at church?"

Discussion Questions.

1. Read 1 Thessalonians 1:1-3 and Ephesians 2:4-10. How and why does genuine faith prompt work for God's kingdom?

Can you think of a recent experience in your own life when your faith in Jesus prompted you to do something?

 Read Matthew 22:37-40. According to 1 Thessalonians 1:3, our "labor should be prompted by love." Explain who shares that love and how it inspires us to act in a certain way.

What's the difference between labor done for compensation or some other tangible reward and labor prompted by love?

- 3. Read Romans 8:22-25. What are we hoping for in Jesus? Are there specific things in your life that you hope for, and why is endurance necessary for true hope?
- 4. Read 1 Thessalonians 1:4-5, 1 Peter 2:9-10, Acts 2:36-41. How do we choose to follow God? How does (did) God choose us?
- 5. Read 1 Thessalonians 1:6-7. Who are you sending messages to or modeling behavior to frequently? Is it a message of faith, love, hope, or joy, or is it a message of judgment, anger, suspicion, or disappointment?

Action Steps.

• Which of these five themes (faith, love, hope, chosen, model) resonated with you most?

• What's one small, specific action step you can take this week?

Prayer.

 Ask for prayer requests, and then pray for boldness to take faith-steps, for a more profound love that labors, for hope that holds onto us, to live as if God chooses us, and to reflect Jesus in how we live.

Optional Challenge for the Week.

• Create a 1-Hour Phone-Free Zone. Use the time to pray, read scripture, or serve someone intentionally.

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
