DISCUSSION GUIDE



Icebreaker: What's one thing you looked forward to when you were a kid—something you wanted to experience before Jesus came back?

Read aloud: 2 Thessalonians 1:1-12.

Discussion Questions:

1. What do you think growing faith and increasing love look like in a church going through hardship?
Have you ever felt your faith grow the most during a painful season?
2. How does your heart respond to the truth that Jesus will return to “pay back trouble to those who trouble you”?
Why is it important to trust God's justice rather than take revenge into our own hands?
3. What is the difference between knowing about Jesus and knowing Him?
Why do you think that distinction is so important to Paul and Jesus?
4. Where in your life do you most long for Jesus to bring relief?
What would it look like to come to Him today for rest, not just someday for rescue?
5. Why do you think Jesus being glorified in His people is such a big deal?

What's one way your life could shine a spotlight on Jesus this week?

6. How would your life look different if you truly lived like Jesus is coming back soon?
What does it mean to be made “worthy of His calling” (v.11)?

Next Steps: Who in your life needs to hear that “grace is still on the table”?

What's one step you can take this week to share the hope of Jesus?

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
