- 5. Read Ephesians 1:15-21. Name three things Paul prays for the Ephesians to receive that will enable them to live Godly, changed lives.
- 6. Read John 5:15. Was it the disabled man's faith in Jesus that healed him? Explain.
- 7. Read Romans 12:2. What does it take to be transformed and understand God's will for our lives? Are we willing to follow Jesus as he makes those changes in us?

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
