List some ways you can get connected or remain connected to the greater body of Christ.

4. Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-7, John 13:35. Based on these scriptures, what's the main thing the body of Christ is supposed to be doing?

5. Is it possible to love somebody at arm's length?

Why can't we simply love God? Why do we have to love people and love people in the church?

6. Read Hebrews 10: 23-25. What causes us to want to quit going to church or gathering together with other Christians?
