- 4. Read Luke 3:1-18 and John 1:6-9. What was John's role?

Why do you think God wanted to have a prophet on hand to announce that Jesus was coming?

What makes John's obedience and acceptance of his role remarkable?

5. Read John 1:10-14. Do you feel like there have been times in your life when you missed Jesus when he was right there in front of you?

What's significant about verse 14?

6. Read Isaiah 9:6. Who is the verse talking about?

How does Jesus embody the four names he is given at the

end of the verse?

7. According to the sermon on Sunday, our calendars and these verses, Jesus's arrival on earth changed history. List some ways this Christmas season you can focus on the Advent of Jesus to help change your corner of the world.
